

## REORGANIZATION FAQ's

### What is reorganization?

In odd number years, as required by state law, Republican precincts must meet in March to elect officers and delegates to their county organization and convention.

### What is the date and time of the Greenville County precinct reorganization meeting?

MONDAY MARCH 22, 2021 7:00 pm

### Where are Greenville GOP Precinct Reorganization Meetings being held?

**At various locations across the county.** Churches, restaurants, schools, private businesses, clubhouses and even a gun range.

**Location list for each precinct will be posted by March 1<sup>st</sup> at [greenvillegop.com](http://greenvillegop.com)**

Not all locations will be decided by then, so check back, especially on March 22 for changes.

### How do I find the name of my precinct?

Find it on your voter registration card OR at **SCVotes.gov**.

On the left side of the page, click "Check my voter registration", enter required information. Suggestion: print the page- it's the same information as your voter registration card and you'll need it at the ReOrg meeting.

Be aware- the name of your precinct is not always the same name as your polling place.

### What if I cannot attend on March 22?

There will be a make-up meeting for all precincts on Tuesday, April 6 7:00 pm at GOP HQ 850 Wade Hampton Blvd.

### Is there a cost for attending this meeting?

**There is no cost for precinct Reorg meeting.**

If you are elected Delegate to county convention- the cost is \$20.

If you want to place your name in nomination to run for state delegate, the cost is \$15.

**FEES MUST BE PAID in CASH or CHECK to Greenville GOP on MARCH 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

### What should I bring to precinct meeting?

Voter Registration Card or print out from SCVotes.org. Know your 9-digit voter number.  
PHOTO ID

Cash or check **IF** you want to be a delegate at county or state convention.

### What are the responsibilities of the Precinct Executive Committeeman?

- Attends County GOP Executive Committee meetings, 6-8 per year.
- Votes for the precinct at these meetings.
- Maintains contact and reports to precinct members when appropriate.
- Works with President to plan the March 2023 Precinct ReOrganization meeting, or in the absence of the President, plans the meeting.

### What are the responsibilities of the Precinct President?

- Calls and presides at precinct meetings.
- Attends County GOP Executive Committee meetings, 6-8 per year.
- Votes for the precinct at these meetings when EC cannot attend.
- Plans the Precinct ReOrganization meeting which will be held in March 2023.

### Are there other offices and elections?

Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and delegates to the county convention are also elected. The officers perform the normal duties expected of their title, support, administrative lists and minutes, and handling money collected and disbursed by the precinct. Delegates to the county convention should be Republican, agree with the platform, and be willing to spend the time and \$ it requires to go to the convention.
