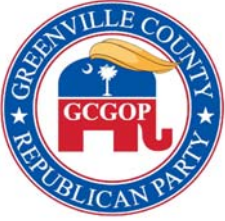

Discussion ensued. Motion to Change “should” to “shall” in last sentence made by Atir Sveska-Sharpe and seconded by Julie Hershey, Ware Place, passed unanimously by voice vote. Discussion ensued. Call to Question, Eric Snyder, Graze Branch. Vote to Accept Resolution with agreed upon changes - passed unanimously by voice vote.

Resolution of the Greenville County Republican Party RE Vaccine Mandates

Whereas any government, institution, or corporate experimental health care **mandate** violates the South Carolina Constitution, Article I, Section 3 which states that “The privileges and immunities of citizens of this State and of the United States under this Constitution shall not be abridged, nor shall any person be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law, nor shall any person be denied the equal protection of the laws.”, and,

Whereas government, institution, and corporate experimental health care **mandates** threaten the jobs of hundreds of thousands of South Carolina workers and their families without due process of law, and,

Whereas South Carolina is a free and sovereign state with a Governor and General Assembly tasked with protecting its citizens’ rights to make their own health care choices, and,

Whereas the South Carolina Republican Party’s position on Health Care is “We believe that free market principles and individual choice ensure the highest quality of Health Care”, and,

Whereas the South Carolina Constitution, Article I, Section 1 provides that “All political power is vested in and derived from the people only; therefore, they have the right at all times to modify their form of government.”

Therefore be it resolved that the Greenville County Republican Party demands that **Governor Henry McMaster, Senate President Harvey Peeler, Speaker of the House Jay Lucas, members of our Republican controlled General Assembly, and all elected, appointed or otherwise serving political and government officials** fulfill their oath to discharge the duties of their respective offices and positions, and preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of this State and of the United States, to protect the rights of the citizens of South Carolina to make their own health care choices and to protect the liberty and livelihood of every South Carolinian by using their authority to **convene immediately a session of the General Assembly** whereby said members shall **consider and pass any and all legislation plausible to deter and prevent any and all health care mandates**, including but not limited to COVID-19 vaccinations, masking, health care passports or other proof of health status for the people of South Carolina. Such legislation shall apply to any and all entities doing business in South Carolina and nullify by any means necessary all Federal actions in this regard by invoking the sovereignty of South Carolina.
