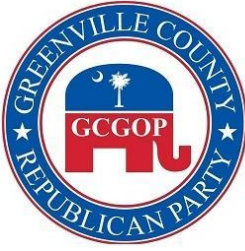

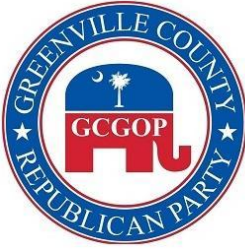

Greenville County School Board Flip Flops on Mobile Vaccine Clinics: The Greenville County School Board originally sided with the parents by voting against having mobile vaccine clinics on school property in an 8-1 vote. Just when we thought this issue was settled, the school board called another vote on this same issue after an apparent amendment was introduced by Derek Lewis. This amendment seemed to add a lot of confusion producing a vote of 6-5 in favor of the mobile clinics before ultimately being tabled until the board is able to better understand what specifically they are voting on. More to come on this topic.

OSHA Vaccine Mandate Halted: Due to the onslaught of legal backlash, including a stay ordered on the mandate by the 5th District Circuit Court, OSHA has revoked all implementation of the vaccine mandate impacting employers with 100+ employees. OSHA will evaluate their stance on an Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) after legal decisions are made. Regardless of this decision, the Biden Administration is advising companies to ignore the courts and continue with the mandate. This mandate is separate from the vaccine mandate impacting federal employees, contractors, and healthcare workers whose employers are subject to Medicaid and Medicare programs.

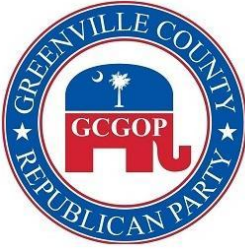

It may have opened us up to the kind of corruption that was seen in Pennsylvania, where it is said, the Hillary Clinton campaign had direct access to the PA registration database, even in 2020! That evidence was found through a Freedom of Information Act request.

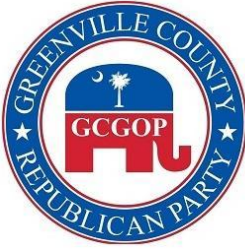

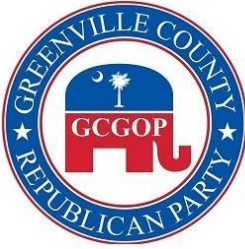

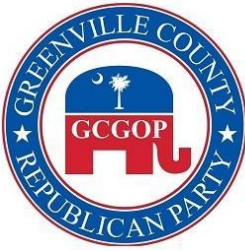

Fabrizio, Lee & Associates recently completed five surveys of $n=600$ likely 2024 voters in the key battleground states of Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin (See methodology statement and key demographics on last page). In all five states, President Trump leads President Biden in a hypothetical 2024 ballot, has a significantly stronger job approval rating than Biden, and seen as better able to handle a host of key issues tested. Simply put, at this juncture battleground state voters want Donald Trump leading this country instead of Joe Biden.

In all 5 Biden 2020 States, Donald Trump Leads on the 2024 Ballot, Including by Double-Digits in Michigan & Wisconsin

In a hypothetical matchup between the current and former Presidents, Donald Trump leads Joe Biden in all five key states tested. In all but Georgia, his lead is outside the margin of error, and in Michigan and Wisconsin, he leads by 12 and 10-points, respectively. There has been a clear shift over the past year, with voters now in favor of President Trump over Biden.

Huge Gap Between Trump and Biden Job Approvals with Trump holding a nearly 20 points or more Advantage

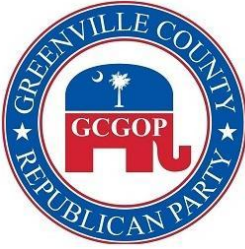
President Trump's approval ratings are a net even or stronger throughout, including +9 in Wisconsin and +6 in Michigan. On the other hand, Biden's approval ratings are incredibly negative. He is underwater double-digits in all five states and in all but Georgia, an outright majority *strongly* disapprove of President Biden.

Trump Dominates Biden on being Best Able to Handle Key Issues Facing U.S.

When asked who was best able to handle the following issues, voters in these five key states selected President Trump by wide margins on stopping illegal immigration, securing the border, controlling federal spending, holding the line on taxes, restoring law & order, dealing with the withdrawal from Afghanistan, getting inflation under control, and rebuilding the economy. Even on issues that Biden ran on, like protecting Social Security & Medicare and rebuilding the nation's infrastructure, more think President Trump is best able to handle. Given his advantage on these key issues for Americans, it's not surprising they are choosing Trump over Biden in these states.
