
Prisma and Bon Secours Stands Down on Vaccine Mandates, Shriners Still Implementing: As litigation makes its way through the courts blocking the Biden Administration's unconstitutional vaccine mandates for Health Care workers and Federal Contractors, many companies are beginning to reverse their original stance on mandate implementation. Unfortunately, not all companies are ready to swallow their pride and change course to protect their employees. At the time of this publication Shriners is continuing to implement their vaccine mandates forcing employees to choose between their jobs and the job. Continue praying for these employees, pressuring our elected officials and coming together to support those who need it in these times.

Shenanigans at the State House: Patriots gathered at the State House on Saturday, December 4th to let their voices be heard and stand for Medical Freedom as the House and Senate reconvened for redistricting the week prior. Our South Carolina elected officials had an opportunity to add the issue of vaccine mandates to their session agenda, however, the vote to adjourn before addressing the unconstitutional mandates prevailed.

Bill H. 3126 - Mask and Vaccine Mandates that was supposed to protect South Carolina workers and their jobs, passed the House unfortunately with no path forward, as the Senate is not scheduled to come back before the regular session starts in January. So the question remains, why members of SC House ignored a Senate bill that had a high probability of passing (with appropriate amendments) and pushed / passed a bill with no path moving forward? Once again ... putting politics over people ...

Greenville County School Board Refrains from Using Students as Propaganda Pawns: The South Carolina Department of Education has partnered with SC DHEC to launch a statewide jingle competition in which K-12 students can "channel their creativity" for a COVID-19 Vaccine campaign. The winning jingle is to be professionally recorded and featured in a statewide radio advertisement in 2022. The winners' school will receive \$10,000 to go toward the school's music program, the runner up will receive \$5,000 and third-place will receive \$3,000. \$18,000 is the value placed on South Carolina children who will be coerced into singing about their own demise; for a shot that doesn't help them, for a virus that doesn't affect them, and for money that will bypass them and go straight to the school system actively indoctrinating them.

Thankfully, the Greenville County School Board has shown restraint on this issue and will spare our children from such subjugation.

Now is an excellent time to reach out on this!



Exposing the Deep State

GCGOP Chairman Jeff Davis Removed from SCGOP State Executive Committee Meeting for Speaking Truth: As many of you have undoubtedly heard, our Chairman Jeff Davis was banned" from all future quarterly SCGOP Executive Committee Meetings in Columbia. This ejection came after Jeff Davis openly addressed corruption within the SCGOP referencing a SLED investigation into an alleged misappropriation of funds by former SCGOP chairman and previous executive director of the


Exceptional SC organization and, Chad Connelly during his oversight of the 501(c)(3). Exceptional SC is a non-profit organization that claims to be “dedicated to supporting exceptional needs students and families in South Carolina.” Chad and some defenders within the SCGOP slandered Davis stating his comments were false and misleading. In a twist of fate, a statement was issued by SLED executive affairs director, Ryan Alphin, Tuesday confirming there is an ongoing SLED investigation contrary to Connelly’s claims. “The request for a preliminary investigation was made by the South Carolina attorney general’s office after receiving a complaint from Jeff Davis regarding misappropriated funds by Chad Connelly. SLED has completed its preliminary investigation into this matter and is currently awaiting further direction from the South Carolina attorney general’s office,” Alphin stated. Nevertheless, a motion was made and passed to remove Davis from the meeting and bar him from any upcoming SCGOP Executive Committee meetings and events. I can say with confidence that we are witnessing the systematic destruction of the old guard and the long-term establishment politicians are panicking as their illegitimate power and positions are being returned to the People.

Ghislaine Maxwell on Trial: Ghislaine Maxwell has spent her most recent time in jail begging for help from judges, lawyers, and now the UN. Recently her brother and sister held a press conference calling on Merrick Garland to meet “three simple requests”: that Ghislaine not be required to wear four-point shackles in transit, that she be fed better meals, and that she have 30 minutes of access to counsel. To date, multiple victims have testified in court along with a few employees of Jeffrey Epstein and have recounted experiences that implicate Ghislaine in the alleged sex trafficking of underaged women. After only 8 short days, the prosecution has rested its case. It is becoming clear that, with the multitude of evidence not admitted in this trial and the speed at which it is progressing, this is not an investigation at all but rather a cover up. The deep state establishment would prefer this be an open and shut case, that you never see the depth of evidence and the massive amount of high ranking celebrities, politicians, and elites that are implicated in this Human Trafficking ring, and that we move on never to speak about it again. I will ensure this is not the case. I, for one, will be shouting from the rooftops and will not allow this to go ignored.


